# "May The 4th Be With You"

\*Closing date for the competition is mid-night on Saturday, 4th May 2024

# **Competition Brief**:

Each year more people are using the expression **"May the 4th be with you"** to celebrate Star Wars Day on May, 4<sup>th</sup>. The Art Yard (TAY) team have set this art competition intended it to be **uplifting** and <u>light hearted</u>.

# **Prizes:**

- 1. The winner from each category (A, B, C & D) will receive an equal share of £400.
- 2. Also, 8 Highly Commended Certificates will be awarded by the judges.

# **Overview:**

- 3. TAY recommends you read this Guide carefully before entering the competition.
- 4. You are invited to enter work <u>light hearted</u> that is **uplifting**.
- 5. There are **4** categories of entry into the competition:
  - Category A. 2D art (original painting, print, craft, etc.) under <1.5m in any direction.
  - Category B. <u>3D</u> sculpture or other arts & crafts.
  - Category C. Photography
  - Category D. Poetry
- 6. Artists can submit up to 5 entries, either into a single category or different categories

- 8. **To entry the competition**: Competition entries should be submitted **on-line** by email.
- 9. The competition entry deadline is 12mid-night, on Saturday, 4th May 2024.

#### **Cost to enter**

- 10. The cost is £2 per entry. (A maximum of 5x entries = £10).
- 11. Payment should be made either; at The Art Yard gallery or direct by Bank transfer to Bank: Lloyds Bank Acc: Midland Film And Art Sort Code: 30 92 35 Account No: 17928460

### **How to Submit Your Competition Entry Form**

- 12. Entry forms should be submitted for preselection by email or handed in at The Art yard.
- 13. Entrants should submit a single **Competition Entry Form** showing **all** entries.
- 14. Each entry should have a title.
- 15. The name or identity of the artist/photographer/poet must not appear on the front of the work itself.
- 16. The medium used **must** be clearly stated on the Competition Entry Form.
- 17. Entrants must be **18 years** old and above on 4<sup>th</sup> May 2024.
- 18. With each work entered into the competition entrants should attach with their email:

- **Category A.** 2D A single **Jpeg** image of the work.
- Category B. 3D Two Jpeg images taken at different angles.
- **Category C.** Photograph A single **Jpeg** image.
- Category D. Poem A single side A4 in .Word or .Pdf format, with a Title and maximum 40 lines.

# **Terms & Conditions**

- 20. All work entered into the competition **MUST** be that created by the artist/poet.
- 21. By entering work into the competition, you agree that the Judges' decision is final and that no further correspondence will be entered into.

# **Judging**

- 22. The judging panel will be made up from TAY team.
- 23. No member of TAY team is eligible to take part in the competition.
- 24. **Judging Criteria**: Entries will be judged using the following criteria: relative relationship to the **uplifting** Competition Brief, distinctiveness, aesthetic qualities (design, composition, colours/tones), concept, complexity, mood, character, selection and application of materials.
- 25. **Preselection:** The judges will use the Competition Brief, the Judging Criteria and your email attachments to select entries to the final selection.
- 26. Artists/photographers/poets will be notified of the results by email.
- 27. **Final Selection**: To be eligible for the final selection, artists **must** deliver their competition entries direct to The Art Yard by a <u>time and date given</u> following preselection, ready for hanging/exhibition at the gallery.
- 28. 2D work, photographs and poems delivered to the gallery **must** be capable of being hung/displayed as part of a normal gallery exhibition and 3D work **must** be capable of being moved easily by one person.
- 29. The Judges will then choose **1x winning** and **2x highly commended** entries for each of the 4x competition entry categories (**A, B, C & D**).

### **Results**

30. The 4 winners and 8 highly commended entrants will be notified by email on 25<sup>th</sup> May 2024.

#### **Exhibition**

- 31. All entries to the final selection will be exhibited at the gallery from 28th May to 1st June 2024.
- 32. Artists/poets are invited to attend the Open Evening between **6:30pm** and **8:00pm** on **Tuesday, 28<sup>th</sup> May 2024** to celebrate the work exhibited, when the **results** of the competition will be announced.
- 33. Winning and highly commended work will be showcased on MFAA(TAY) website and social media.
- 34. All winners will be expected to provide a short biography (80 words max) and their photograph.
